SEBASTIAN KNEIPP AWARD

The value of the Prize is € 10,000.-

For scientific publications providing new research contributions to the
KNEIPP THERAPY

The award recognizes outstanding research in the following fields:

1. Contributions examining the synergistic effects of combinations of herbal therapy with one or more other Kneipp therapy principles (hydrotherapy, nutrition, exercise, life balance).
2. Contributions to the effects and efficacy of medicinal plants or preparations as well as in particular also the identification of active compounds, or the clarification of the acting mechanisms of a plant or its compounds.
3. Contributions to the combined effect of several phytogetic ingredients in the sense of an indication or for influencing a symptom.

To apply for the award, please send an original manuscript or publication, which has been accepted by a scientific journal, in German or English language in two copies and also on CD-ROM, together with the curriculum vitae, to: Sebastian-Kneipp-Stiftung, Dr. Bruno Frank, Am Grundbach 5, D-97271 Kleinrinderfeld. The deadline for submission is **December 1, 2015**. It is possible to submit papers which are not yet published (but submitted for publication) as well as submitted publications (date of publication not older than 3 years).

A summary of the paper including the following points is required:

1. Does the publication make a contribution to the therapeutic progress (including explanatory statement)?
2. What relevance does the publication have concerning a possible benefit for the patient/user?
3. What relevance does the publication have for the scientific justification of the Kneipp Therapy?

If more than one publication is presented, a summary of all publications is required (a summary of each publication and a final summary of all papers). The jury consists of renowned scientists of German and International universities. The prize will be awarded excluding the jurisdiction of a court. The award can be shared. Publications submitted and not considered in this year can participate in the prize announcement in the following two years.
